Barry Hill, Esq.; Anapol, Schwartz, Weiss, Cohan, Feldman & Smalley, P.C.; Wheeling, W.Va.

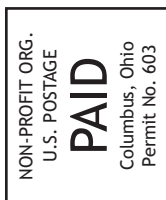
